I wouldn't have it any other way. I only just met Ryder this morning and it's good to get out of the parish every now and again. Now if you'll excuse me for a minute I need to go "dig a hole" if you know what I mean.

ALL LAUGH. FATHER HIGGENS LEAVES, LAUGHING BEGINS TO SUBSIDE.

RYDER

Back off, I saw him first.

STOLY

What's that supposed to mean?

RYDER

Oh come on, I saw what was in your back pack - chloroform, plastic wrap, and knives.

STOLY

You must have me mistaken

RYDER

(sighs)

Look, I only know because I packed the same things. I'm a serial killer and you are too.

HOLDS UP ITEMS.

STOLY

I'm not saying whether I am or not Father Higgens is a priest.

RYDER

The priest is gay. He's been making eyes at me all night. I've killed 4 gay men before and tonight will make 5.

RYDER IS PUTTING ON GLOVES AS HE SPEAKS.

STOLY

I thought your type was "lonely campers"?

RYDER

Well, that's the campground killer's type which is why I should be asking you the same question, Campground killer.

STOLY

I'm not the Campground killer.

RYDER

Yeah, yeah, you're just an innocent camper that carries chloroform and plastic wrap.

STOLY

It's not chloroform, it's (chloroform substitute). It's cheaper and more effective.

RYDER

Really? I got to look it up.

STOLY

Totally, and make sure to get nonporous tape. Porous tape leaves trace evidence and blood residue.

RYDER

(finishes Stoly's sentence)

...blood residue. Yeah! Totally, wow, thanks.

STOLY

Two serial killers meeting way out here, what a small world.

RYDER

Yeah, it's nice to talk shop. I spend so much time hiding my identity from everyone.

STOLY

Yeah totally.

BOTH HAVE A MOMENT TO ENJOY THE COINCIDENCE THEN BACK TO BUSINESS.

RYDER

STOLY STARTS TO GET AGITATED IN A SERIAL KILLER FRENZY TYPE WAY.

STOLY

RYDER

RYDER

BLACKOUT.
