SANDY

Betsy! Oh it's good to see you

THEY EMBRACE

SANDY (CONT'D)

And you must be, Johnny.

JOHNNY

Yes, ma'am. I know you must be worried about your daughter but I assure you she's in good hands.

RON

Hands?

SANDY

Oh, I don't like the sound of that.

BETSY

C'mon, mom. Give him a break he's just a little nervous.

RON

Yo, Johnny boy, there's no need to be nervous. Sit down, put your feet up.

SANDY

Yeah, we just want to know who she's spending time with.

JOHNNY

"With whom she's spending time" Ah yes, you want to set a baseline for expectations.

RON

Wha? Look our goal is just her happiness.

JOHNNY

A great goal, and I hope for to
achieve that goal through our
sessions.

SANDY

We don't mean like...in bed.

JOHNNY

In bed, in the shower, even at the
dinner table, I will be working your
daughter at all times. That's what

SANDY

RON
